Pinot Grigio,

Counterpoint South Eastern Australia. medium bodied and soft, with pear flavours and a little hint of spice.

Chardonnay,

Granfort Chardonnay, Pays d'Oc. A bunch of fresh stone fruits on the palate, with a crisp and mineral-driven texture.

Antao Vaz,

Esporão Alandra Branco, Alentejo Southern Portugal. Cool-fermented and unoaked, the wine shows aromatic notes of white peach and orange peel.

Sauvignon Blanc,

Petal & Stem Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough New Zealand. The wine expresses pure fruit flavours of guava and passionfruit, that dance out of the glass with underlying notes of grapefruit and blackcurrant leaf.

Shiraz,



Rebeland Swartland Shiraz, South Africa. Finely crafted to portray layers of cherry, soft prune, blackcurrant and hints of black pepper spice.

Malbec,



Élevé Malbec, Pays d'Oc. Malbec's original home is in south-west France; vines were taken from here to plant vineyards in Argentina and Chile. Velvety, fruit-driven wine with bramble fruit and violet aromas alongside some spice on the palate

Ribera Tempranillo,



Damana 5 Tinto Ribera del Duero, Castilla y Leon NW Spain. With the extreme climatic conditions coupled with the heartier soils, Tempranillo from the Ribera del Duero tends to be more robust than that of Rioja with typically darker fruits, cherry, black berries and sometimes cassis.

Pinot Noir,



Le Versant Pinot Noir IGP d'Oc. Delicate colour with garnet tones. On the nose it has aromas of cherries, wild strawberries and fresh blackcurrant. An elegant and smooth palate, with fruity, smoky and minty hints.

Primitivo,



Masseria Borgo Dei Trulli Lucale Primitivo, Appasimento IGP Puglia, Italy. Puglia, spread between vineyards and olive groves, you can find numerous ancient dry stone dwellings called Trull, hence the name of this wine. A full-bodied wine, it is supple and well-balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.

Carignan,



La Picoutine Carignan Grenache Vin de France. A soft, medium-bodied and fruity wine, with flavours of red plum and cherry. Beautifully balanced with good length on the finish.

St-Emilion Grand Cru,



Chateau Viramiere St-Emilion Grand Cru. Chateau Viramiere is a stunning winery located in the heart of the Saint-Emilion appellation in Bordeaux. The wine is a deep ruby red with aromas of black cherry and earthy undertones, with a palate

Grenache - Art De Vivre,

Gerard Bertrand Art De Vivre Red, Occitanie. Art de vivre is a tribute to the Mediterranean cradle, its preserved nature and its artists. Its unique bottle, made of natural clay, is an evocation of the first amphoras. This wine embodies the essence of the Languedoc region in France.

Made from a blend of Syrah, Grenache, and Mourvèdre grapes, it is a bold and complex red wine that boasts a beautiful ruby color. The nose is intense with aromas of ripe berries, spices, and vanilla, while the palate is full-bodied with a rich and supple texture. The finish is long and smooth, filled with notes of dark chocolate and roasted coffee. This wine is perfect to pair with grilled meats, game, or robust cheeses. It is a wine that truly embodies the art of living.
